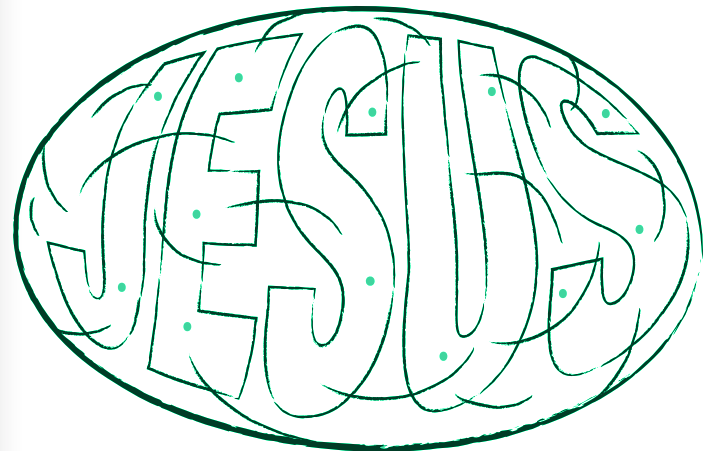
GET STARTED

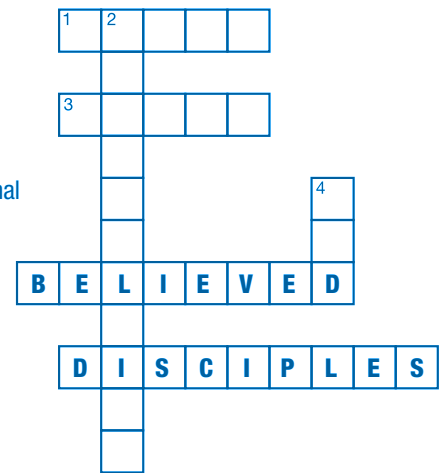
